Dr. Frank Hu is Professor of Nutrition and Epidemiology at Harvard School of Public Health. He also serves as Director of Boston Obesity and Nutrition Research Center Epidemiology and Genetics Core.

He was the recipient of American Heart Association Established Investigator Award and American Diabetes Association Research Award. Dr. Hu is an internationally recognized researcher in epidemiologic studies of obesity, diabetes, and cardiovascular disease. He has published extensively on nutritional and genetic factors of these conditions as well as gene-environment interactions. His recently published textbook "Obesity Epidemiology" (Oxford University Press, 2008) provides a comprehensive and in-depth review of current evidence on both determinants and consequences of obesity.
